# **Library News**

We've recently added a number of new books to the club library and will have them available at our January meeting. Look for the table full of the new additions. Two of the books that might be of interest to you are:

**Build Stuff With Wood** by Asa Christiana. If you are new to woodworking this might be the book for you. The author presents a number of projects (including a rolling workstation, cutting board, wood slab table and floating shelf) that can be made without having a full shop of big woodworking tools. You'll learn a lot of useful things such as working your way thru grits of sandpaper when finishing a project, how to safely us a compact router to shape edges, how to glue-ups and what are some great, simple finishes for your projects.

*The Practical Workshop* by Christopher Schwarz. This book is on the other end of the spectrum and is a more advanced guide to workbenches, layout and tools. Get ideas for how to build a simple workbench, design an efficient shop and have enough storage for all of your equipment. It includes some great plans for workshop stands and worktables.

Library check out is for 2 months and open to all club members.
