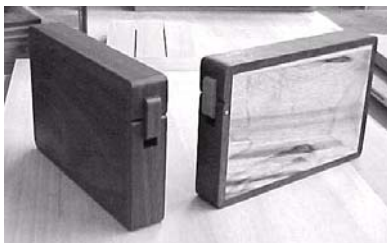
will be a good meeting!

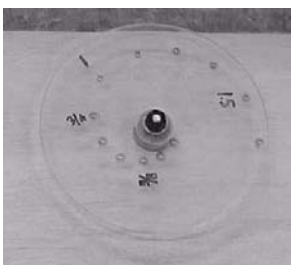

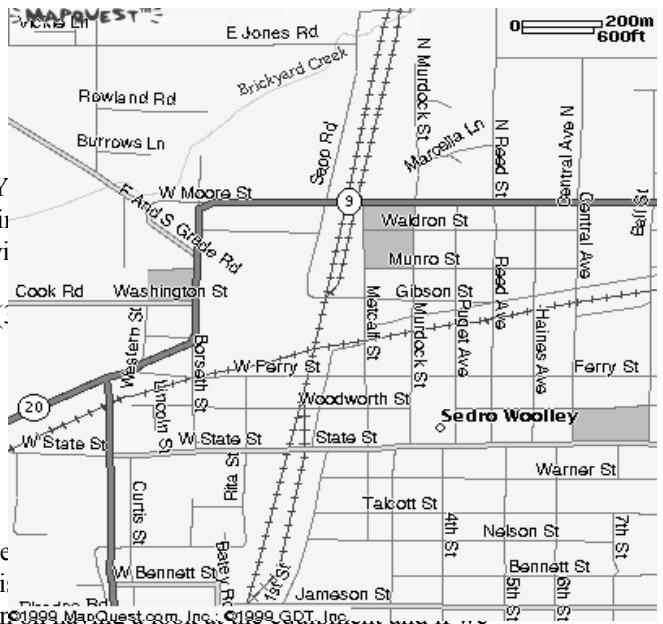

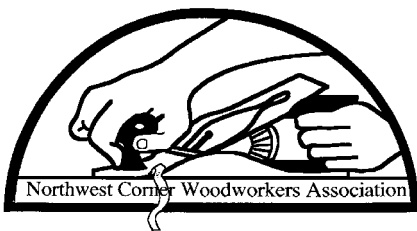
